



## SASKATCHEWAN HISTORY & FOLKLORE SOCIETY, INC. APPLICATION FOR SHFS LEGACY FUND AWARD

The Saskatchewan History & Folklore Society, Inc. (SHFS) offers one bursary of \$300 to assist a full-time undergraduate student who is currently enrolled at the University of Regina. This bursary is made possible by estate gifts received by the Society.

WHO CAN APPLY: Students who have made application and meet the following criteria:

- enrolled in either the College of Arts & Science or Education;
- his or her major area of study is Western Canadian Plains History;
- submission of an essay about a topic of the Society's choosing;
- academic merit.

The applicant's current and previous final marks transcripts must be submitted. They will be photocopied and returned to the applicant. Such transcripts are necessary to establish the applicant's area of study in Western Canadian Plains History, and their academic merit.

The recipient will be selected on the combined basis of academic merit (50%) and a written essay (50%).

The essay should be 750 words in length with the subject being: "Why is it important to study Western Plains history?" Essays must be double-spaced, with an appropriate cover page. Hand written essays are not acceptable.

Deadline for applications are September 15 (Fall semester) or January 31 (Winter semester).

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
